Spéos Photo School provides Professional Photography Training in English and French, both in Paris and London, including a fully accredited European Masters of Photography Award and RNCP level I (the highest level of qualification in French Vocational Training).

Since 2015, Magnum Photos and Spéos have partnered to create a unique one-year Master's Award in **Creative Documentary & Photojournalism in Paris**.

In 2016, Spéos also developed a new Masters Level **Fashion Photography Programme** in collaboration with the iconic photographers Paolo Roversi and Dominique Issermann.

Spéos has collaborated for many decades with most of the international giants of photography such as Magnum Photos, Gamma, Reuters, Nikon, Canon, Minolta, Konica and Fuji Film.

Spéos has also created its own learning technique, based around "The Stop System", published and distributed by Kodak books in French and in English, and presently taught in numerous American Universities.

Since its establishment in 1984, during the past 30 years, Spéos has trained more than 4,000 students from over 50 different countries. Spéos Alumni have gained multiple major awards and many are now recognised as top experts in their genre, both in their own countries and internationally.

Spéos Photo School is also very concerned with ongoing research and in preserving a very significant French National Heritage site: The **Nicéphore Niépce House Museum**.

This is the location where the very first photograph in the world was taken by the true inventor of photography, Nicéphore Niépce, some years before Daguerre and Fox Talbot. The Museum was awarded the prestigious label "**Maison des Illustres**" by the French Ministry of Culture in 2013, with sponsorship of the Académie des Sciences & the Académie des Beaux-Arts.
